August 6, 2020 Local General Election & Primary Voting

As part of our HOA Advocacy efforts, we are encouraging all TV homeowners to vote.

During the upcoming August 6th Primary and Local General Election, in Tennessee and Loudon and Monroe Counties specifically, several statewide candidates will be selected to run in the November General Election and several local issues and positions will be decided.

We All Need to Vote in This Election!

This is the second in a series of emails from the HOA to assist Tellico Village homeowners and residents in voting in the upcoming primary election.

We plan to send out the 3rd Special Election Edition of the Voice around the last week of June to provide time for homeowners to review Candidate responses prior to casting their vote by mail or in person.

Note: At the time of publication much of the information from Monroe County had not been finalized. As a result, the information in this edition is specifically for Loudon County voters. Registration and voting dates are the same for Monroe County. Ballots, candidates and voting locations will obviously be different. These will be provided in the next Special Election Edition of the Voice.

Key Dates

Registering to Vote

• The last day to register to vote in the August 6th Primary is July 20, 2020.

Voting By-Mail (Absentee Voting By-Mail)

- Mail-in/Absentee Ballot Requests can be made from May 8th to July 30th Important: When requesting a ballot – you will need to select a political party (see info on candidates running below)
- A voted ballot must be returned to the Election Commission Office by the United States Post Office, FedEx, UPS or other courier service by the closing of the polls at 8 P.M. on Election Day. *Voted ballots cannot be hand delivered to the Election Commission office*.

Voting in Person

- In-Person Early Voting, (Absentee Voting In-Person)
 - July 17th through August 1^{st)} at a polling place list below
 - Election Commission Office in Loudon
 - Roane State Community College in Lenoir City.
 - \circ July 22nd through July 24th
 - Christian Life Center of the Community Church of Tellico Village
 - The Tellico Village location will only be open these days for In-Person Early Voting

- In-Person Election Day Voting
 - August 6th at your assigned polling place (place will be advised in future).

Your questions should not be specific only to your special situation but should be applicable to the general population of Tellico Village and surrounding community. *Please submit your questions no later than Friday, June 5th*.

Submitted questions will be reviewed by the HOA Board of Directors – the final list of questions will be determined at the sole discretion of the HOA Board of Directors. We will provide an adequate period for each candidate to provide a response to the questions if they so choose. We will summarize their responses and provide them to you for your consideration.

List of Questions to Candidates by Office

All Candidates

- Why are you running for office?
- What are the three things you would like to accomplish if elected (or reelected) to this office?
- Why should residents of Tellico Village vote for you?

School Board

- What is/are the most critical issue(s) facing the school district?
- What would you propose to address those issues?
- From a volunteer perspective, how do you view Tellico Village's participation and support of local schools currently and into the future? Please share examples.

Tennessee House of Representatives

- The waterways of Tennessee and specifically Lake Tellico are under threat of an Asian Carp invasion. This could have significant negative impacts on the lake's ecosystem and environment, Tellico Village and surrounding area property values, area lifestyle and leisure activities. What actions have you taken as an incumbent, or will take if newly elected to this office?
- How will you stay connected to Tellico Village and listen to the special needs of the village?
- Based on your current knowledge, how will you engage in defining and addressing the needs of Tellico Village?
- When schools reopen, a new 'normal' for education will need to be established. Going forward, what do you feel the top priorities and solutions should be to ensure the safety of students and delivery of a quality education? How should they be funded?

US Senate/US House of Representatives

- The waterways of Tennessee and specifically Lake Tellico are under threat of an Asian Carp invasion. This could have significant negative impacts on the lake's ecosystem and environment, Tellico Village and surrounding area property values, area lifestyle and leisure activities. What actions have you taken as an incumbent, or will take if newly elected to this office?
- How will you protect social security for today's seniors and strengthen it for future generations?
- Long-term global environmental impact issues are constantly in the news. In your opinion, what are the top three environmental issues facing the US that Tellico Village residents should be concerned about? What have you done, or will be doing to address them?
- Congress appears to be gridlocked due to partisan politics. What will you do to help break the gridlock? What will be the primary driver of your voting?





Early Voting Schedule (Loudon County)

Early Voting in Loudon County for the State of Tennessee Federal/State Primary Election and Loudon County General Election will be held from Friday, July 17 through Saturday, August 1, 2020 at the Election Commission Office in Loudon and at the Roane State Community College in Lenoir City. The Tellico Village location will only be open form July 22-24, 2020. You can vote at any of the 3 Early Voting locations during the Early Voting period during the hours of operation at each location.
