Local General Election & Primary Voting

As part of our HOA Advocacy efforts, we are encouraging all TV homeowners to vote.

During the upcoming August 6th Primary and Local General Election, in Tennessee and Loudon and Monroe Counties specifically, several statewide candidates will be selected to run in the November General Election and several local issues and positions will be decided.

We All Need to Vote in This Election!

This is the third in a series of emails from the HOA to assist Tellico Village homeowners and residents in voting in the upcoming primary election.

Important Information for Mail-in Voting:

Unless you are on the permanent absentee voting register or enrolled in the Safe at Home program, you must appear in-person to vote in the first election after you have registered by mail. If you have already voted in-person since you registered, then no additional information will be required to vote by mail.

Federal, State & Local Candidate Information

As promised HOA sent out questionnaire requests to candidates (most via email and some by mail) on the upcoming ballot asking them to answer several key questions of interest to Tellico Village residents. Because of the late date of receiving candidate contact information for Monroe County candidates their questionnaires did not go out until July 1st. Unfortunately, the response rate has been very low, resulting in insufficient information to do a comparison of the responses currently.

The Candidate Information page includes a list of candidates participating in the August 6th voting sorted by party affiliation, and by county for the local elections. Next to the candidates name you will find a website for the candidate, if they have one, which you can click on to take you to their site. There are also two columns at the right of the page, one is marked with a 'X' if a questionnaire has been sent to them and the next column will have a link to the candidate's response to our questionnaire if they returned it. Key Dates

Registering to Vote

- The last day to register to vote in the August 6th Primary is July 20, 2020.

Voting By-Mail (Absentee Voting By-Mail)

- Mail-in/Absentee Ballot Requests can be made from May 8th to July 30th
Important: When requesting a ballot – you will need to select a political party (see info on candidates running below)
- A voted ballot must be returned to the Election Commission Office by the United States Post Office, FedEx, UPS or other courier service by the closing of the polls at 8 P.M. on Election Day. **Voted ballots cannot be hand delivered to the Election Commission office.**

 - Roane State Community College in Lenoir City.
 - **July 22nd through July 24th in Tellico Village at New Location**

 - The Tellico Village location will only be open these days for In-Person Early Voting

Early Voting in Loudon County for the State of Tennessee Federal/State Primary Election and Loudon County General Election will be held **from Friday, July 17 through Saturday, August 1, 2020 at the Election Commission Office in Loudon and at the Roane State Community College in Lenoir City. The Tellico Village location will only be open form July 22-24, 2020.** You can vote at any of the 3 Early Voting locations during the Early Voting period during the hours of operation at each location.
