- Select your reason for requesting to vote by mail in Section 3.
- Read the statement in Step 4 and sign and date the Request. An electronic/digital signature is not acceptable.
- If the voter cannot sign their own name, he or she may make an "X" or other mark in the signature box. If the voter cannot sign their own name or if other assistance is given in completing the Request, the person assisting and one witness must provide their address and sign and date the Request.
- A Power of Attorney is not valid for election purposes. You cannot vote on behalf of someone else.
