As part of our HOA Advocacy efforts, this is the 4th in a series of emails from your HOA to assist Tellico Village homeowners and residents in voting in the November 3rd election.

It's As Easy As 1,2,3!

Step 1 – Check Your Voter Registration and Polling Place

The easiest way to do this is to go to this website:

Voter Registration Information Lookup And Absentee By-Mail Status Tracker https://tnmap.tn.gov/voterlookup/

At this site, you can check on:

- 1. Your voter registration personal information and voter ID
- 2. If you voted by Absentee Mail-In Ballot, you can check the status of your ballot
- 3. Your assigned <u>Election Day</u> polling location, address, map link, and hours. (For Early Voting, you click on a link on the site that will take you to all early voting locations in your county).
- 4. All your voting information including Precinct, TN Senate and House Districts, US Congressional District, and County District.







Step 2 – Once You've Decided When and Where to Vote,
Make Sure You Have the Proper Picture ID and Take It With You
When You Vote



All voters must present a federal or Tennessee state ID containing the voter's name and photograph when voting at the polls, whether voting early or on Election Day unless an exemption applies.

Many types of IDs are accepted. For a comprehensive list and samples of acceptable IDs, click on the document icon below:

Step 3 – Go to Your Voting Location and Vote Either Early or on Election Day

Early Voting Begins on October 14th through October 29th
Election Day is November 3rd
