#### Problem Statement:

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is building a bridge over the Tennessee River which will replace the Highway 321 Bridge over the Fort Loudon Dam and TDOT is building another bridge parallel to the existing bridge over the channel that connects Fort Loudon and Tellico Lakes. This construction project has created concerns among Tellico Village homeowners about the impact on traffic safety during construction. Also of concern is the condition of the Tellico Parkway (Highway 444) and the lack of acceleration and deceleration lanes and left turn lanes at most intersection along the Parkway. Adding such lanes, repaving deteriorated sections of the Parkway and improving the transitions between the highway and bridges would substantially improve traffic safety and improve the overall appearance of Tellico Village.

#### In Scope:

- 1. Maintain communication with TDOT to learn about and provide public input to the Tennessee River Bridges and improvements to Highway 321 and Highway 444.
- 2. Provide timely reports on the work of the HOA TDOT Liaison Committee to the Home Owners Association
- 3. Participate in the formal comment process, if any, on the behalf of the HOA during public comment periods

### Out of Scope:

- 1. The committee should not represent any entity other than the TV HOA.
- 2. The committee should not provide certified technical or engineering advice to TDOT

#### Strategic Goal:

Avoid adverse impacts to Tellico Village residents during construction especially temporary traffic patterns

#### Project Objectives:

- 1. Establish the HOA TDOT Liaison Committee as a credible source of community feedback and suggestions for the TDOT projects that directly affect Village residents
- 2. Establish a communication and meeting protocol with TDOT
- 3. Establish a collaborative working relationship with TDOT
- 4. Confer with TVPOA as needed to ensure efforts are unified and are not in conflict.

#### Project Deliverables:

- 1. Develop meeting reports and any other information updates for community publication and presentations at TV HOA meetings.
- 2. HOA Comments to TDOT during public comment periods, if any
